## - Continue to rehabilitate shanties

damaged by high water, including The Otherside, Ice House, and Welcome Center.

- Resolve infrastructure issues related to high water levels and water flow.
- Reintroduce native species to the landscape.
- Improve public access to the site.
- Build an endowment to ensure that Fishtown Preservation can protect and care for Fishtown now and into the future.
- Install donor wall in Fishtown.

The remaining projects will continue through 2023.

Fishtown Preservation can do this work only in the off-season, to allow the small Fishtown business owners the full warm season. Projects of this scope also require a lot of room, which limits how many can be done at a time.
The effects of the high water and Covid have substantially raised the cost of and extent of the rehabilitation and construction projects.
